FOOD HYGIENE RATING

Rate card

We ask for 20% commission from all food traders, calculated on net turnover, with a non-refundable minimum pitch fee. This minimum pitch fee is payable prior to the Festival and deducted from the total commission due at the end of the Festival.

The Canteen is our main covered dining area, but there are other limited opportunities in our family area, an outdoor space that typically closes earlier in the evening.

Power and WiFi is charged separately and items not provided that you will need to bring:

- Front of house marquee or unit structure
- Back of house equipment and structures, e.g. fridge unit, van storage facilities, etc.
- Decoration and signage, including detailed menu boards and allergy signage
